Amplify in Partnership

A recent example of the power of partnership was highlighted on BBC Points West, showcasing the work of schools within Amplify in developing a new national primary music curriculum in collaboration with Oak National Academy and Bristol Beacon.

This project brings together teachers, music specialists and leading arts organisations to create a high quality, fully resourced music curriculum that is free for all primary schools to use. The project was jointly led between the Beacon and Amplify and our schools among the first in the country to trial the curriculum, helping to shape lessons that are engaging, inclusive and accessible for all children.

As a trust, Amplify is proud to be part of this work. Partnership projects like this mean that successful practice developed in our schools can be shared more widely, while also giving our pupils access to rich creative opportunities. Over time, this collaboration will allow more of our schools to benefit from – and contribute to – this free national music curriculum, strengthening music education for children across Bristol and beyond.

The All Together Now trust concert will take place on Wednesday 29 April 2026 at the Bristol Beacon, bringing together pupils across Amplify for a celebration of music, collaboration and creativity.
